Discover an informed explanation of fantasy vs reality, aesthetics vs practicality through toys with characteristics of Outerspace from the MINT Museum of Toys' 'Outerspace' collection and learn imagination, exploration, innovative storytelling, extrapolation and visualisation techniques.

- Development of various concepts to generate iterative solutions.
